



GOVERNORS AND SAFEGUARDING

The governing body has an overall responsibility to oversee the boarding community and to ensure that boarders are properly provided for, including:

- Safeguarding
- Health and Safety
- Boarders' welfare
- Compliance with the National Minimum Standards for Boarding Schools.

The Designated Safeguarding Governor for the College is **Vicky Flind**, who chairs the Governors' Safeguarding Committee. Ms Flind works closely with the Deputy Master Pastoral (Fiona Angel), who reports any concerns she has to Ms Flind. Ms Flind receives safeguarding and child protection training at least once every two years, including training provided by Southwark Social Services.

In addition, another Governor (**Peter Thompson**) has specific responsibility for the Safeguarding & Pastoral aspects of Boarding. Mr Thompson visits the boarding houses and meets with the Boarding House Masters periodically. He also liaises with the Medical Centre.
